



More Martin County teens are choosing not to use alcohol and other drugs: 72 percent did not use alcohol, 86 percent did not use marijuana, and 87 percent did not participate in binge drinking.* Public education provided by United Way's CHARACTER COUNTS! program and & Tykes & Teens, a United Way-funded agency, are contributing factors in the decreased usage.

In partnership with the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 1041, Martin Veterans was formed to create a resource guide for veterans, a directory of local businesses owned by veterans and a system to match veterans to businesses needing their skills.



WHITE DOVES HOLIDAY PROJECT/TOYS FOR TOTS

As a result of a community-wide effort to help struggling families during the holidays, 1,206 local families with 2,790 children received food and toys through the annual White Doves Holiday Project/Toys for Tots program. This service was made possible thanks to the 227 individual and group volunteers who contributed 1,948 hours to collect, sort, display and distribute 12,108 toys and 17,000 pounds of food.
